1. Share with Administration

Successful implementation of CASE curriculum begins with the support of your school administration.

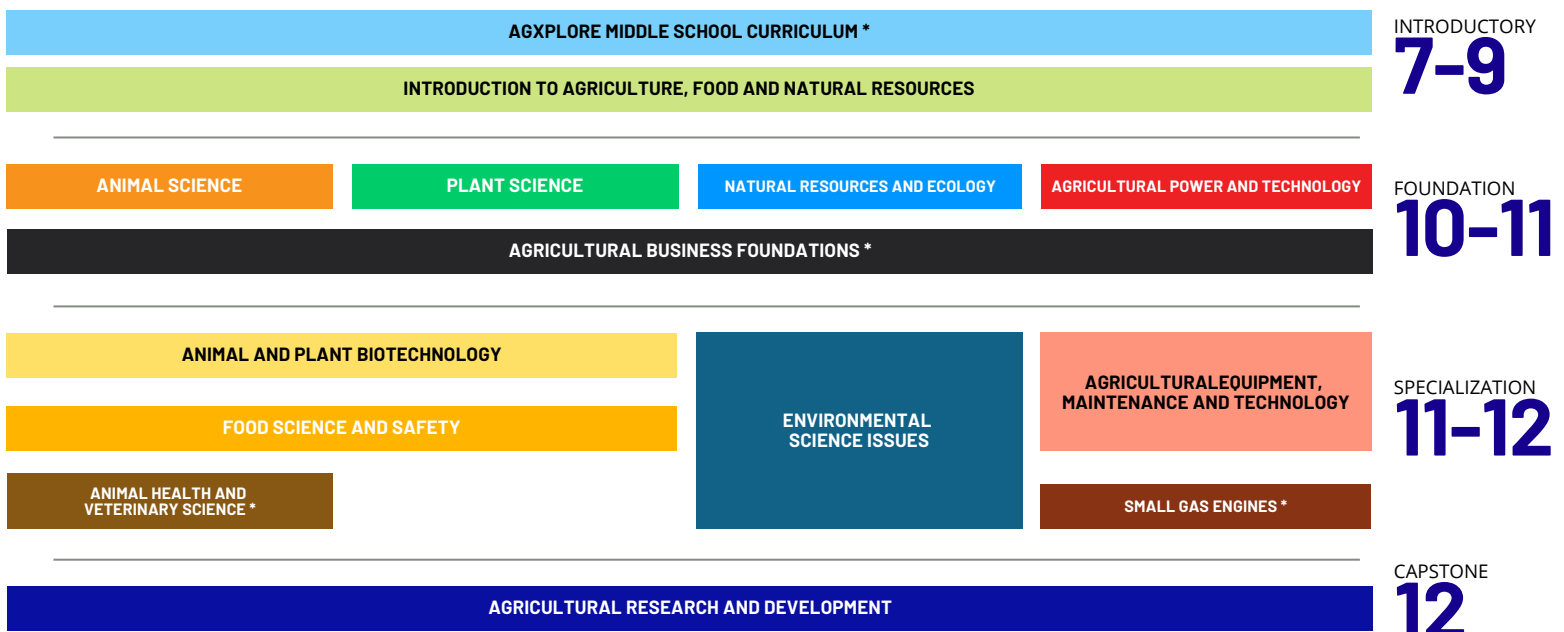
Benefits of adding CASE in your school include:

2. Select Courses

Work with your school to choose from the menu of CASE courses that best fit your local student and industry needs to develop a pathway of study. CASE recommends choosing courses from two or more levels to build a student's inquiry-based and independent learning skills. The sequence may be exclusively CASE course offerings or a combination of CASE and local curricular offerings. 3. Attend Professional Development

CASE has two types of professional development events that provide teachers the content and skills needed to use CASE curricula in their classrooms. CASE Institutes prepare teachers to implement full-year CASE courses. Institutes range from five to eight days in a hybrid, in-person, or virtual format. BriefCASE events are for shortened CASE courses or modules and range from one to three days.

Create a MyCASE account to see current professional development offerings. Registration can be paid for by purchase order or credit card.

In-Person/Hybrid CASE Institute registration fees range from \$2,250 - \$2,950
Virtual CASE Institute registration fees range from \$1,750 - \$3,250
Virtual institute costs include materials and equipment.

BriefCASE registration fees range from \$450 - \$800

Professional development scholarships are available to help fund teacher attendance and certification.



4. Implement Curriculum

CASE certified teachers use their online MyCASE dashboard to access curriculum, teacher notes, Powerpoints®, student activity instructions and assessments. Course work is adaptable and customizable based on teacher preference to fit all geographies and communities.

The cost for supplies and equipment will vary, depending on your program's situation. Implementation grants provide funding for schools to purchase classroom equipment and materials.
